required and must be submitted by email to bids@danville.ca.gov. Upon submittal of bids, an automatic email confirmation will be sent to the bidder acknowledging receipt. If the automatic email confirmation is not received, bidders must contact the person listed in the questions section on page 2 of this notice to bidders by 2:00 pm on Tuesday, March 11, 2025, to verify the bid has been received.

The Town will allow electronic submittal of bids until 2:00 pm on Tuesday, March 11, 2025. Original documents of the bid submittal must be post marked on or before Tuesday, March 11, 2025 and received within five (5) business days of the electronic submittal. **Bids that are not submitted timely in both electronic and hard copy forms will not be considered."**

- 4) **Appendix A, Area G (Page 9):** A callout has been added to the plan to install VDS in place of the loops (revised plan attached).

**List of Questions & Answers:**

	Item # 17 Traffic Loop Detectors:
Q1	The bid schedule shows a quantity of 3 but I don't see any loops called for on the plan sheets. Can you please clarify where these loops need to be installed? Also, does the quantity of 3 mean - 3 individual loops? or 3 lanes of 4 loops in each lane? or something else?
A1	Some dig-outs are near existing loops, which may need to be replaced as part of the project.
	Bid Item # 18 Traffic Video Detection System (Camera):
Q2	The bid schedule shows a quantity of 3 but the plan sheets only call for two locations to get video detection - Camino Tassajara @ Alta Vista and Camino Tassajara @ Wood Ranch. Can you please clarify exactly which intersections are getting video detection systems and how many cameras need to be installed at each intersection?
A2	The third camera will be installed at Tunbridge Road at Sycamore Valley Road
Q3	The bid schedule for the above project lists tree trimming as one lump sum. We cannot bid this item without knowing a quantity. Please clarify.
A3	Trimming shall be limited to the minimum necessary to accommodate the Contractor's equipment for construction operations. Before paving, trees, shrubs, and other vegetation at risk of shedding leaves or branches onto the pavement or asphalt concrete shall be neatly trimmed. The Contractor is responsible for determining the extent of trimming required to facilitate the necessary work.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

1. This addendum No. 1 consists of a total of 5 pages.
2. The Bid Items are presented to indicate major categories of the work for purposes of comparable bid analysis and payment breakdown for monthly progress payments. Bid items are not intended to be exclusive descriptions of work categories, and the Contractor shall be deemed to have included in its pricing all staging, materials, multiple handling, labor, and equipment to complete the entire project as shown and specified, regardless of whether a specific pay item is provided.

Contractor is advised that where no pay item is listed in the bid schedule, the cost for the work described in these Construction Details, Plans and Specifications shall be considered as included in the prices paid for the various contract items of work involved and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

3. **Bidders are reminded that this addendum must be noted on page P-16 of the Proposal Package when they submit their bid, and in doing so the Contractor acknowledges receiving all pages of the addendum. Failure to acknowledge receipt of this addendum will result in a non-responsive bid.**




