Honoring Joseph A. Calabrigo

for 40 Years of Distinguished Service

WHEREAS, Joseph A. Calabrigo has faithfully and honorably served as the Town Manager of Danville for 32 years, providing steadfast leadership and an unwavering commitment to public service in Danville for 40 years; and

WHEREAS, Joseph A. Calabrigo has led the Town through transformative growth, maintained a balanced budget through numerous economic cycles, and championed the development of critical infrastructure, public safety, and virtually all of the civic amenities that have enhanced the quality of life for all residents; and

WHEREAS, Joseph A. Calabrigo has set a high standard of professionalism, integrity, and public stewardship, becoming the longest-continuously-serving city manager in the Western United States; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Calabrigo began his career with the Town in 1985 as Chief of Planning and has also served as Transportation Director, Administrative Services Director, and Assistant Town Manager, contributing significantly to the development of all three of the Town's General Plans and both Downtown Master Plans; and

WHEREAS, under his guidance, the Town of Danville has maintained a balanced budget every year, including through three recessions and a global pandemic, demonstrating fiscal responsibility and resilience; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Calabrigo has worked alongside 20 councilmembers and 7 police chiefs, fostering collaboration and leadership across the region and has served with humility, vision, and dedication, earning the respect of staff, elected officials, regional leaders, and the broader community; and


