

## Swimming Levels:

Level	Age	Culminating Skill Assessment
<b>Preschool A Shallow End</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	3-5Y	Putting head under three times, being comfortable in the water on front and back, submerge mouth and nose while blowing bubbles for three seconds, glide on front for two body lengths, then roll to back and float on back for two seconds (with support).
<b>Preschool B Shallow End</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	3-5Y	Swim five feet without support on front and back, float on back for 15 seconds without support, front float for five seconds roll to back float for five additional seconds.
<b>Level 1 Shallow End</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	6-12Y	Swim five feet without support on front and back, float on back for 15 seconds without support, front float for five seconds, roll to back, float for five seconds.
<b>Level 2 Shallow End</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	4-12Y	Swimming freestyle, backstroke and breaststroke for 15 feet, equivalent to one-quarter of the length of the pool.
<b>Level 3 7ft Depth</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	4-12Y	Side-breathing while swimming freestyle and backstroke 15 yards, equivalent to one-half of the length of the pool, tread water for 30 seconds, kneeling dive.
<b>Level 4 7ft Depth</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	4-12Y	Swimming two consecutive laps, freestyle, backstroke and breaststroke 25 yards, butterfly 15 yards, tread water for two minutes.
<b>Level 5 Deep End</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes	4-12Y	Freestyle, backstroke and breaststroke 50 yards, butterfly 25 yards, swimming six consecutive laps, swimming an individual medley (IM) and treading water for five minutes.
<b>Private Lessons</b> Lesson: 30 Minutes		All swim levels

Private swim lessons are 30 minutes long and held Monday–Thursday for one week. Each participant receives personalized instruction based on their skill level and may need to move to an alternate class time if necessary. If a class is full, add your child to the waitlist in case additional spots open. To advance levels, swimmers must demonstrate all skills listed in their Culminating Skill Assessment. Complete skill charts are available online to help determine proper placement.

## Preschool Aquatics Program - Level A

Age 3-5Y | Town Staff | See Learn to Swim Details

Level A introduces young swimmers to water safety and comfort through fun, instructor-led games and activities. Parents do not participate, and the 1:5 instructor-to-child ratio ensures plenty of guidance. The skills listed below must be demonstrated to graduate from this level: submerging the head, blowing bubbles for three seconds, gliding on the front for two body lengths and rolling to a supported back float for two seconds. Repeating levels is common as confidence grows. If a class is full, add your child to the waitlist so we can accommodate more participants when possible.


Level B builds on Level A, helping swimmers gain more independence and improve body control in the water with a 1:5 instructor-to-child ratio. Instructors focus on safety, floating and basic stroke movements in a fun, supportive setting. The skills listed below must be demonstrated to graduate from this level: swimming five feet on front and back without support, floating on the back for 15 seconds and transitioning from front to back floats for five seconds each. It's common to repeat this level for confidence. If a class is full, please add your child to the waitlist for future openings.



If you complete this course successfully, are hired on to the Town of Danville Aquatics Staff for the summer of 2026 and complete a full season of employment with a passing evaluation, you will receive \$200 back for your certification.

### When do I register?

Registration begins for incorporated Danville residents on Tuesday, February 10 at 8:00 AM. Open registration begins Tuesday, February 17 at 8:00 AM.

### How do I register?

Online: Register online by setting up and logging into your account at [danville.ca.gov/recguide](http://danville.ca.gov/recguide). We encourage you to set up your account prior to the registration date. This will ensure that you receive the lessons you want quickly. For assistance, please call 925-314-3400.

In Person: Please come into the Danville Community Center at 420 Front Street from Mondays – Thursdays from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM and Fridays from 8:00 AM – 1:00 PM.

### How do I select my child's class level?

Please refer to Swimming Levels Table with qualifying age and prerequisite skills needed in the order listed. To move to subsequent levels, swimmers must consistently perform all culminating skills. Your child should enroll in the lowest level lesson that they can perform a culminating skill repeatedly. Sometimes, swimmers may need to retake lessons or repeat levels after prolonged periods without practice. Please note that if the wrong swim level is chosen, we will only be able to provide a refund with Town credit only. We also will not be able to accommodate changing the participant to the correct level.

### What if my participant cannot pass a swim test?

If your participant cannot pass a swim test, your participant will be asked to withdraw from the course. If you sign your participant up for a level that they do not meet the prerequisite and cannot pass the swim test, you will only be refunded with Town credit.

### What happens if my child passes the class, but I registered the child for the same level next session?

If there is space available, your child will be transferred to the correct level. Please contact the Danville Community Center prior to 1:00 PM on Friday to accommodate potential transfers.

### Is it possible to make up a class that my child missed due to illness or vacation?

Unfortunately, there will be no make-up classes due to illness or vacation.



# Policies

## General Information

Pre-registration with payment is required for program participation.

Advise Town staff if participant has a disability or allergy requiring special accommodations.

## Americans with Disabilities Act

In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Town of Danville encourages those with disabilities to participate in our programs. If you have any special needs that require specific accommodations so you can fully enjoy our classes and programs, call 925-314-3400.

## Course Cancellation

When registration falls below the minimum enrollment required, it may be necessary to cancel a class or program. At the time of cancellation, the Town will initiate a full refund-minus transaction fee. Check refunds may take 4-6 weeks.

## Photo/Video Liability Disclosure

Photographs and video may be taken of participants during a class or program, and these photographs and video may be used for Town of Danville publicity purposes.

## Rainouts and Class Make-ups

Whenever possible, make-ups will be given on those occasions when inclement weather or instructor illness requires that a class be cancelled. See instructor at next scheduled meeting for make-up date. No refunds (whole or partial) can be given for classes missed by the student.

## Waitlists

Waitlists will be created once a class has reached maximum enrollment. If space becomes available, you will be contacted.

## Withdrawals (Credits/Refunds)

Requests for withdrawal will be honored if requested no later than five business days prior to the first day of the activity. There will be a \$15 withdrawal fee assessed for each activity.

A \$20 processing fee will be charged for processing refunds made by check. We do not provide cash refunds.

Requests made less than five business days prior to the first day of the activity must be submitted using the online withdrawal form and will be considered on an individual basis. If withdrawal request is approved, there will be a \$15 withdrawal fee assessed for each activity.

Withdrawals for sports leagues may be approved if a team can be replaced before the first game.

## Residency Status Clarification

Those living outside the Danville Town limits include residents of the communities of Alamo and Diablo, Alamo Creek, Bettencourt Ranch, Blackhawk, Bryan Ranch, Monterosso, Shadow Creek and Whitegate housing developments.

The program and facility fees cover a large portion of the actual costs, though Town of Danville residents also partially support the classes, events and facilities through their property tax assessments. Because of this, those program participants and individuals reserving Town facilities who live outside of Danville pay an additional non-resident charge.
