HAP MAGEE RANCH PARK

1025 La Gonda Way

One of northern California's greatest assets is its suitable weather which allows for an outdoor wedding almost any time of year. Create lasting memories amidst the enchanting backdrops of the Meadow and Gazebo at Hap Magee Ranch Park. Set between the rolling foothills of Danville and Alamo, this 17-acre park remains separated from the surrounding residential area by mature oaks, pines and sycamore trees. The facility has three ranch-style homes which can be reserved for various events such as weddings, parties, birthdays and corporate meetings. Also available for rental is the expansive meadow for large outdoor gatherings. A charming gazebo is a picture perfect spot to say "I do." Hap Magee Ranch Park has a storied past; it was once a ranch for longhorn steer; prior to that, it served as a summer camp for orphans from San Francisco. No two events are the same at this popular location. Consider it a blank canvas to create a dream occasion.

201 Front Street

Located in downtown Danville, the Town Meeting Hall is the site of Town Council and Town Commission meetings. This Spanish colonial style building provides a unique venue for individuals who enjoy an open ceiling concept with rustic wooden beams spanning across the auditorium. There is ample natural light in the main room which gives a warm and comfortable feeling as you enter the building. Located next to the Village Theatre and Art Gallery, public parking is just steps away. The Town Meeting Hall also contains a kitchen, smaller meeting room, and a nice courtyard right outside the main entrance. This is the perfect location for smaller weddings, parties, meetings, and other intimate gatherings. The charm of this unique and convenient facility will impress and even surprise your guests. VILLAGE THEATRE AND ART GALLERY

233 Front Street

Built in 1873, the Village Theatre has been used as a farmer's lodge, Grange Hall, movie theatre, and church. Recognized as a historic site by the Heritage Resource Commission, the building now serves as a performing arts theatre with a fine arts gallery located in the lobby. The gallery hosts six quality art exhibits and receptions a year. The theatre includes dressing rooms, a renovated sound system and upgraded tech booth that offer a wide range of sound equipment including on-stage monitors, microphones, and a front-of-house PA system. The lighting grid features 96 ETC sensor dimmers that create intricate lighting shows. Trained staff provide basic lighting or may work with your lighting designer to ensure your needs are met.

Occasions are made special right in the heart of Downtown Danville. Events of all sizes will enjoy the Community Hall, as it can be divided into thirds, creating three smaller rooms or a medium-sized room for those in-between sized groups. The bright promenade facing E. Prospect Avenue features three sets of double doors that open to the plaza area where guests gather to enjoy treasured moments. A meeting room, small conference room and art room are also available for a meeting of the minds or small parties.

RENTAL INFORMATION

Whether it is an intimate baby shower, a corporate retreat or a much grander affair, the Town of Danville provides unique spaces for any occasion.

The Town of Danville does not have a preferred caterers list but can provide a resource list of vendors that have been used in the past.

Available for a fee, amenities include audio/visual equipment, cocktail tables, and lecterns. A complete list of available additional equipment is provided on the Facility Use Application. Public Access Wi-Fi is available at most locations.

- Reservations are confirmed after deposit has been made and you have received a reservation confirmation.
- All applications are tentative until a reservation permit is issued.
- If a reservation is not made 90 days in advance, full payment is due and payable to the Town of Danville as issuance of a reservation permit.
- Deposit is due at time of booking, and may NOT be applied toward rental fees, but is fully refundable pending no damages/overtime.

- Any catered events must include the kitchen.
- Tables and chairs are included in the rental rate for indoor facilities.
- Facilities staff is available by appointment to tour any of the sites and answer any questions.



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
