There are over 3,100 parking spots downtown. Each time you or your staff use on-street parking or high-demand lots, you take a convenient spot for a customer.

GET PERMITS FOR YOUR STAFF

Each employee should get a Downtown Employee Parking Permit, which allows ALL DAY parking in designated zones—and Zone 1 is FREE this year!

LEAD BY EXAMPLE

Encourage your employees to use their parking permits, and lead by example by doing the same. Avoid “parking hockey”—it’s bad for business—employees are away from the business AND it takes prime parking spaces away from customers.

If you are a business owner or employee of Downtown Danville, you are eligible to purchase an employee parking permit for all day parking privileges, in designated areas of the Downtown marked:

ALL DAY PARKING BY PERMIT ONLY

1 PARKING PERMIT LOCATIONS AND FEES

Employee permit parking locations are divided into three “zones” throughout the Downtown, and can be found by referencing the parking permit map below. Permit holders must park within the corresponding zones indicated on the permit. Please note: “Zone 2” and “Zone 3” permits are also valid in “Zone 1.”

2 WHERE TO PLACE YOUR PARKING PERMIT

Parking Permits are nontransferable stickers, and need to be attached directly to the inside surface of the front windshield on the lower left-hand corner (driver’s side). If you change vehicles or have your windshield replaced over the course of the year, you will be required to submit updated vehicle and license plate information to the Danville Police Department to be issued a new sticker.

3 HOW TO ORDER YOUR PERMIT

You will need to verify your place of employment for a parking permit. To do this, submit a recent pay stub or business card that includes your name, business name, and business address.

METHOD 1 (PREFERRED)

Upload verification documents electronically through the online purchasing process, or once you finish the online application send your documents to Parking_Permits@Danville.ca.gov. Upon verification, your permit will be mailed to you directly.

METHOD 2

Submit verification documents in-person to the Danville Police Department, 510 La Gonda Way, 8:30 a.m.—5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. Upon verification, a permit will be issued over-the-counter. Please note that if you choose to come in to the Police Department, wait times may vary depending on staff priorities.
