

REBUTTAL TO THE ARGUMENT AGAINST MEASURE Y

The opposition to YES on Y has repeatedly made inaccurate and inflammatory statements that tear at the fabric of our Town and neighborly political discourse. Their "Argument Against Measure Y" is no exception.

These are the facts about YES on Y:

Traffic FACT: Makes the first improvements in decades on Diablo Road at Green Valley Road and Mt. Diablo Scenic Boulevard intersections. The Final Environmental Impact Report concludes these traffic improvements "would improve operating conditions by significantly reducing existing delay along the Diablo Road corridor."

School Capacity FACT: San Ramon Valley Unified School District's own projections show local schools below capacity. Additional students can be accommodated without issue, and Measure Y will generate revenue for the district.

Cyclist Safety FACT: Improves safety by dedicating lands to the Town to extend the paved off-street bike/pedestrian trail along Diablo Road, giving walkers and cyclists new safer alternatives to a dangerous section of road. Every major bike group in Danville supports YES on Y.

Open Space FACT: Current zoning allows up to 78 hillside homes across the entire 410-acre property, with no public access. Yes on Y unlocks this currently privately-owned property by converting 381 acres into new, publicly-accessible open space—permanently protected by the East Bay Regional Park District and others—so families can enjoy miles of new trails forever.

Wildfire Evacuation FACT: San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District (SRVFPD) says Measure Y does not affect its ability to respond to fires and emergencies. SRVFPD's Deputy Fire Chief/Fire Marshal said it exceeds California's fire code requirements with a new emergency vehicle access route along Diablo Road.
