

## Danville Community Pianos ~ Summer 2022



The Town of Danville is seeking experienced middle school and high school art students from the SRVUSD to submit original designs for the re-painting of the *Danville Community Pianos* for the summer of 2022. This is open to current middle school students and current high school students, including the graduating class of 2022 high school seniors.

The Town has three pianos to place downtown for all to enjoy and play this summer! Artists who wish to participate will submit colored sketches of their designs for what they envision for the piano (limit, one design per person and/or "art team").

Artists are free to illustrate any concept they would like to but should consider that their design needs to be a clear representation of what the final project will look like, and it should be appropriate for public display.



### **Selection & Approval Process**

- 1) The "Danville Community Pianos" Selection Committee will review all submission packages for inclusion
  - 2) All artists will be informed as to whether their design was selected or not by the committee by Monday, June 6, 2022
  - 3) The Town will provide paint and materials and the painting will take place onsite at the Danville Community Center during business hours the weeks of June 13- June 24, 2022.
- \*Please consider your planned holidays when applying. Artists must be available these weeks.

### **Please submit the following by May 20, 2022 at 10 p.m.**

- 1) Artist Agreement (signed) one per artist and/or if working with a partner or group, one per art team, please note names of all persons on "art team."
  - 2) Copyright Agreement (signed)
  - 3) One color sketch created from piano templates enclosed (see below for piano outline to be colored in with original design). Design should carry out from front to back.

- June 6, 2022: Artists notified if their design has been selected
- June 13-June 24, 2022 10 a.m. – 4 p.m.: Painting to commence at the Danville Community Center and continue each day during this week until the artwork is completed.
- June 24, 2022: Painting of Piano must be complete
- June 27, 2022: Pianos will be placed outside for all to play and enjoy through Labor Day

### **Copyright Assignment:**

WHEREAS, (artist's name \_\_\_\_\_), an individual is the Author of the design and sketches (collectively referred to as the "Design") attached to the application submitted to the "Danville Community Pianos" committee on the same date of this assignment; WHEREAS, the Artist understands and acknowledges that, as part of the application process, it is intended that Town of Danville, department of Recreation Arts and Community Services, with an address of 420 Front Street, Danville, CA 94526, owns the entire right, title and interest in and to the Design;

WHEREAS, the Artist understands and acknowledges that he/she will be notified in writing by the "Danville Community Pianos" committee when their design has been approved and selected;

WHEREAS, the Artist understands and acknowledges that upon the artist's receipt of written notification that their design has been selected and approved, they shall apply that design to a piano (provided by the Town of Danville) thereby creating a "Finished Piano" ready for outdoor display during the summer of 2022.

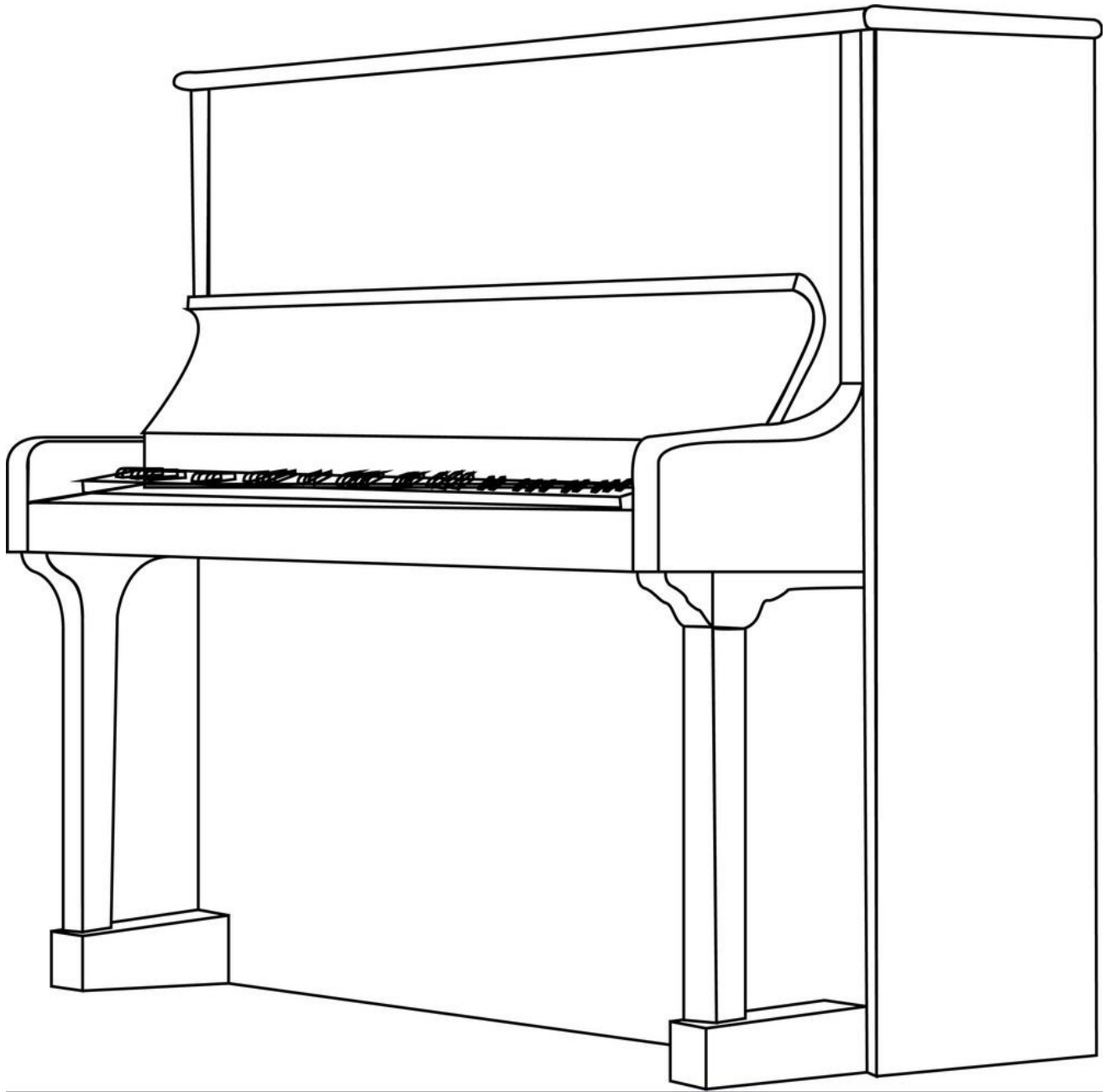
WHEREAS, the Artist desires to transfer all of his/her right, title and interest in and to the Design, including but not limited to, all derivative works which are based on the Design to the Danville Community Pianos, Committee;

WHEREAS, the Artist understands and acknowledges that the Danville Community Pianos, Committee shall

continue to be the sole and exclusive owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the Design, including, but not limited to, all derivative works based on the Design of the "Finished Piano" is approved for exhibition as described in detail in the Call for Artists to Danville Community Pianos. Artist hereby assigns to the Danville Community Pianos all their right, title and interest in and to the Design and to any derivative works based on the Design including but not limited to any rights it may have in the Finished Piano, together with all copyright application and registrations therefore. The Artist acknowledges and agrees that, due to the nature of the public display of the Finished Piano, the Town shall not be liable for any distortion, mutilation, modification or destruction of the Finished Piano by accident, act of God or person. The Artist hereby waives his/her rights under the Visual Artists Rights Act ("VARA"), 17 U.S.C. 106A, as against Town of Danville.

The Artist further acknowledges and agrees that if the Finished Piano is vandalized, damaged or otherwise modified and the Artist is unable or unwilling to promptly repair such alteration, "Town of Danville" shall have the right to make, or have made, such repairs, even if the repairs would constitute distortion, mutilation or modification under VARA. The Artist hereby waives his/her rights under VARA in the event and to the extent "Town of Danville" deems such repair necessary.

The Artist represents to "Town of Danville" that they are the sole author of the Design and that the Design is an original work of authorship which does not infringe upon the copyright rights or an intellectual property rights of others, and that they have the unencumbered right to make this assignment. In the event the Design is not approved or selected for exhibition, as described in the Call for Artists, "Danville Community Pianos" (Town of Danville) shall assign (and hereby does assign) back to the Artist all its right, titles and interest in and to the Designs.
